


Early Momentum (First Year) Indicators from Student Success Metrics – Cohort

"Decline in enrollment" from first to second term in 2020-21 (~inverse of persistence), by ethnicity






Contextual note: Persistence from students' first terms to their second terms, visualized as the percentage of students not persisting, from the Student Success Metrics Cohort View

Previously enrolled









Preliminary Results – Fall 2022 Statewide Survey of California Community College Applicants. Sample of 46,011 previously enrolled students and 35,785 students who had applied but not previously enrolled. Students who had not enrolled in Fall 2022 were asked to provide reasons affecting their decision. Percentages are of students who provided at least one reason (12,232 previously enrolled students and 6,054 not previously enrolled students). Respondents may select more than one reason.
