ISSUE 2	<p>OVERVIEW AND PERSPECTIVE FROM THE LEGISLATIVE ANALYST'S OFFICE (LAO)</p> <p>No actions were taken under this item.</p>
ISSUE 3	<p>ADVOCACY REQUESTS</p> <p>These issues were held open, no action was taken.</p>
ISSUE 4	<p>HOME AND COMMUNITY BASED SERVICES REGULATIONS COMPLIANCE AND GOVERNOR'S TRAILER BILL LANGUAGE (TBL) REQUEST #633</p> <p>The Subcommittee took action to ask DDS to put together a "Plan of Action for HCBS Compliance" and to submit this to the Subcommittee by the May Revision. This could include reflections on the issues raised by the LAO and other stakeholders, be informed by the applications for the assistance funding, and map out how compliance with HCBS will be achieved to protect federal funding before the March 2019 deadline. The Subcommittee held the trailer bill proposal open.</p>
