




WILLOW GLEN STUDIOS ON PEDRO STREET

- Provides interim housing support for people on path to permanent housing
- HHAPP funds supported rehab and are currently supporting operations
- 144 individuals have moved to permanent housing



EXPANSION OF HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION







HOMEKEY FUNDING

- Local Approach Utilize Homekey to identify a range of housing opportunities that address current gaps and add capacity to the housing system.
- Close coordination between County, local cities, nonprofit operators and service providers
- Results:
 - Total of \$222,104,646 in Homekey funding across 10 projects
 - Projects awarded in five cities San José, Mountain View, Milpitas, Santa Clara, Palo Alto
 - 224 NEW Permanent affordable and supportive housing units from 270 hotel rooms
 - <u>283 NEW Interim Housing units</u> from hotel conversion/rehab (to be converted to permanent housing later)
 - 412 NEW Interim Housing units occupied or in development using modular construction
