The Department of Information Technology (DOIT) was created by SB 1 (Alquist), Chapter 508, Statutes of 1995, and has the responsibility for the strategic direction and oversight of the State's information technology investments.

■ Major Provision

The major provision of the Department of Information Technology budget include:

- \$500,000 reduction and budget bill language allowing for reinstatement of the funds provided that the department issues final policies for IT procurement; security; infrastructure; accessibility; and pilot of feasibility report.
