



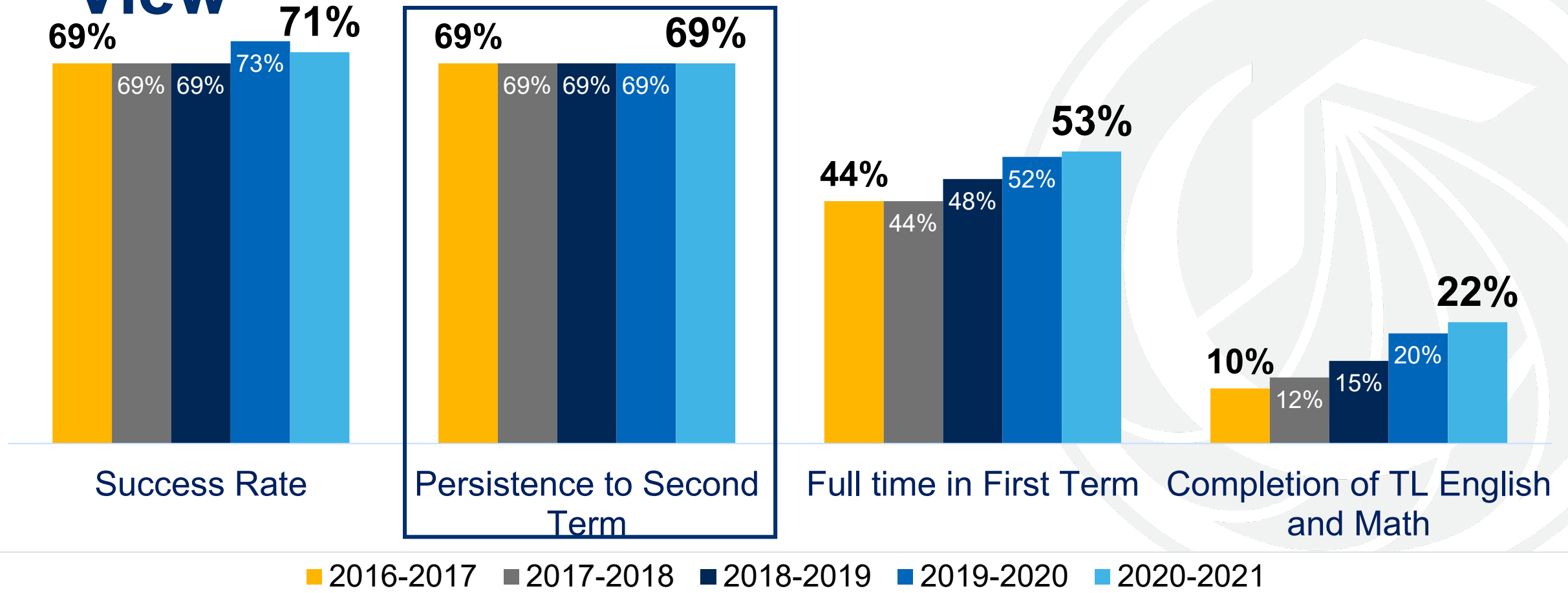

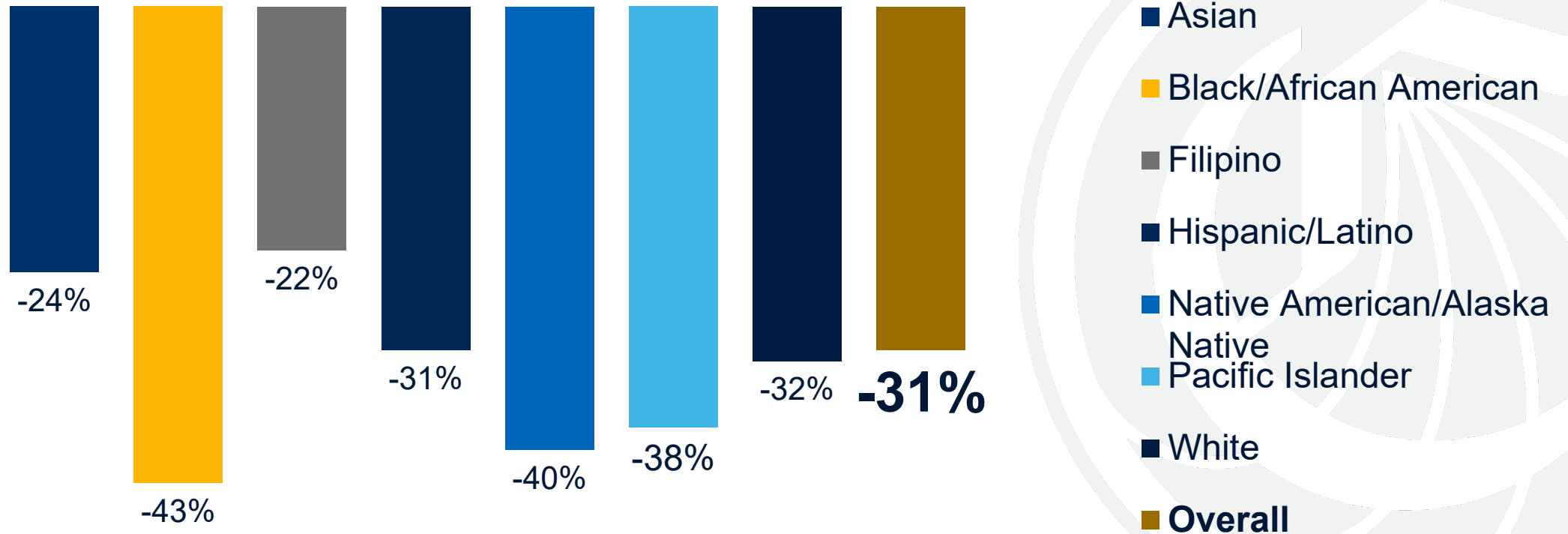

Early Momentum (First Year) Indicators from Student Success Metrics – Cohort View

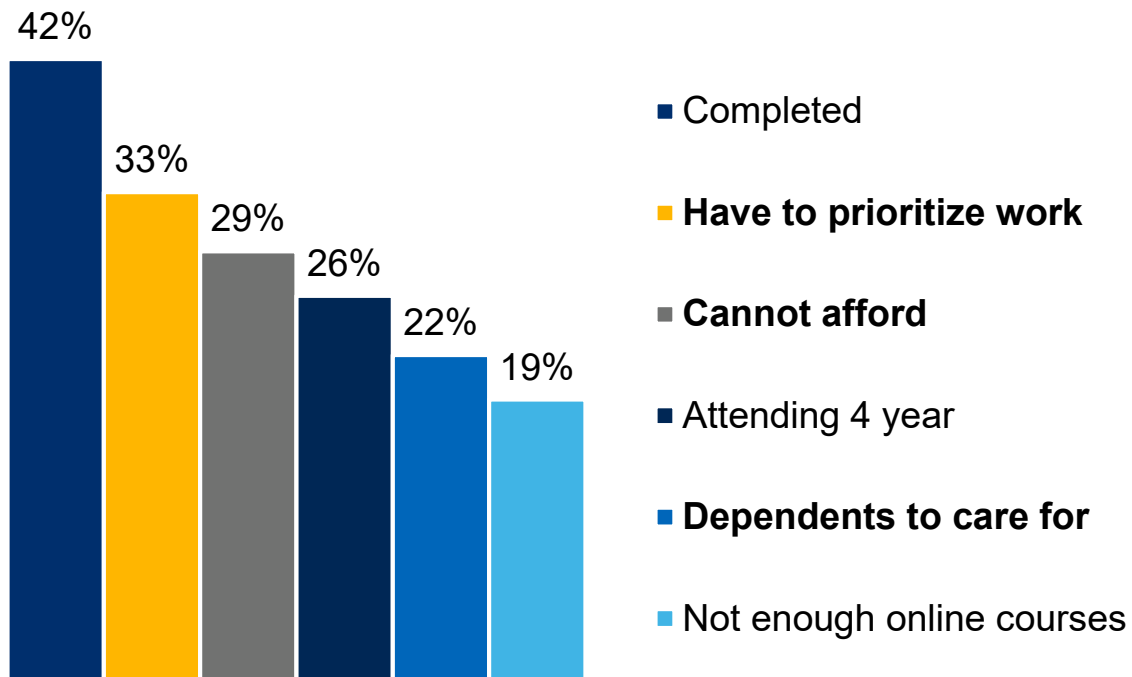


“Decline in enrollment” from first to second term in 2020-21 (~inverse of persistence), by ethnicity

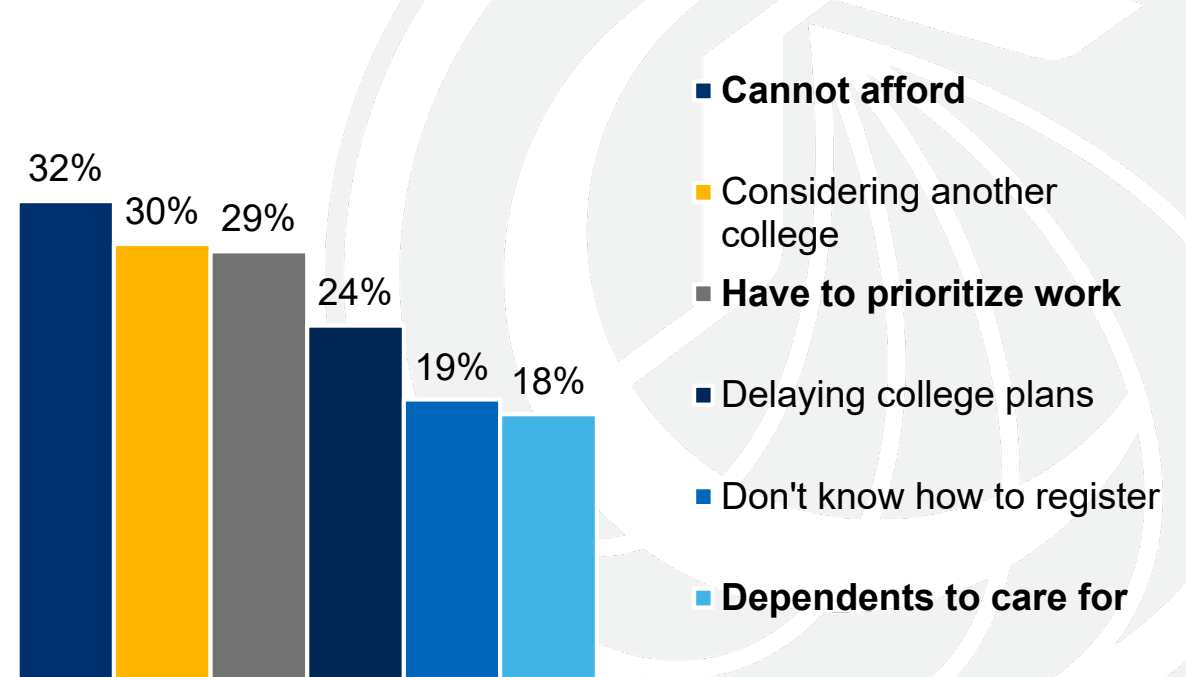


Factors influencing students' decision to enroll

Previously enrolled

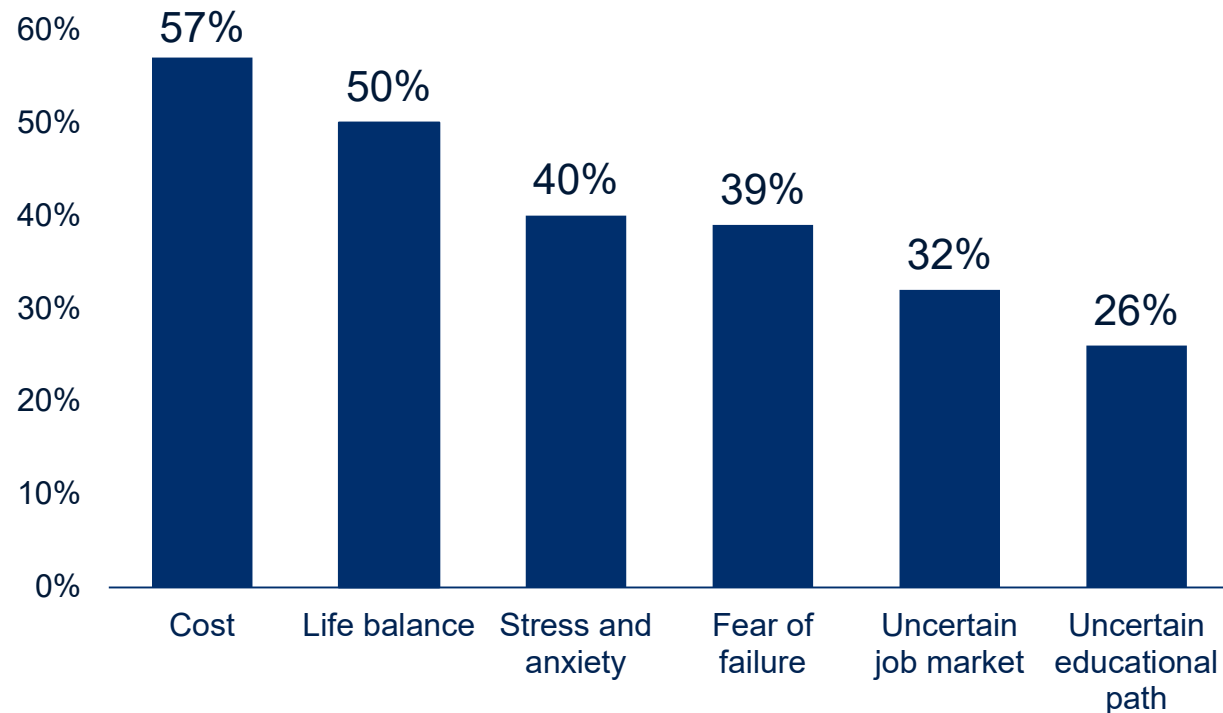


Applied, not previously enrolled

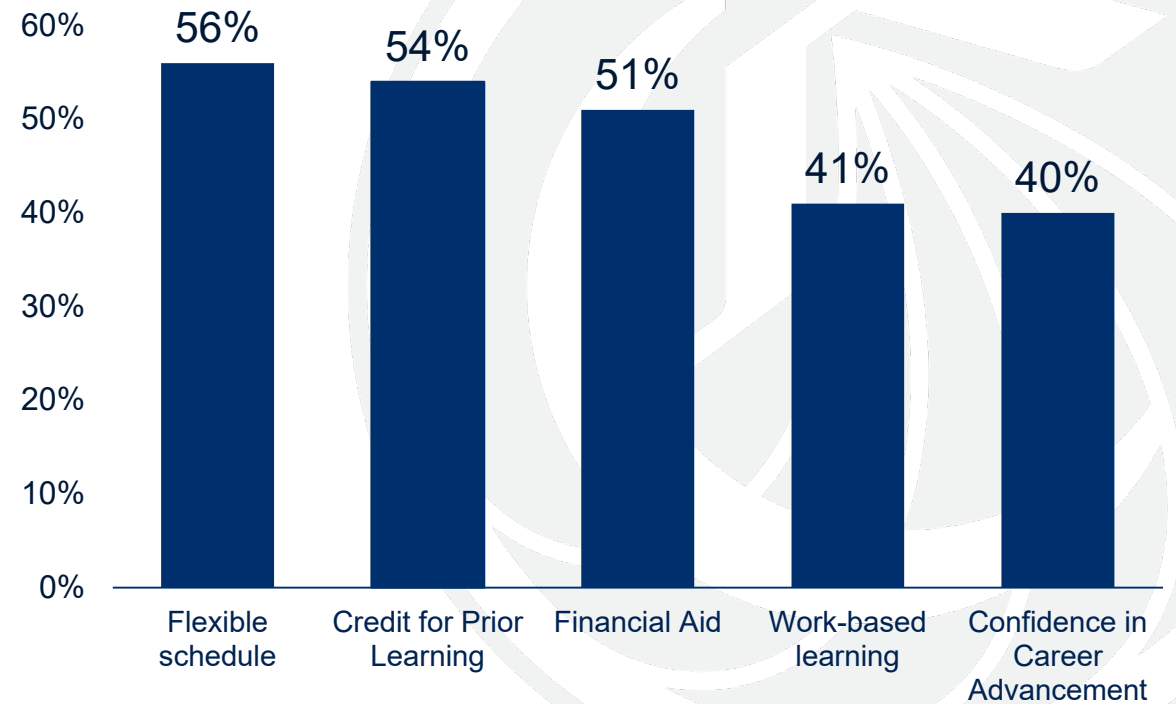
