ISSUE 3	ARMED PROHIBITED PERSONS SYSTEM WORKLOAD  <b>ACTION:</b> Approve as budgeted. <b>Vote:</b> 3-Ayes (Feuer, Alejo, Blumenfield), 1 No (Morrell)
ISSUE 4	HAWKINS DATA CENTER [Chapter 745, Statutes of 2011 (AB 809)]  <b>ACTION:</b> Approve as budgeted. <b>Vote:</b> 3-Ayes (Feuer, Alejo, Blumenfield), 1 No (Morrell)
ISSUE 5	LEGAL SERVICES ALLOCATIONS AND SMALL CLIENT POT  <b>ACTION:</b> Augment DOJ's budget by \$600,000 from the Indian Gaming Special Distribution Fund and delay by one year the proposed \$1.9 million increase in DOJ's General Fund appropriation for legal services. <b>Vote:</b> 3-Ayes (Feuer, Alejo, Blumenfield), 1 No (Morrell)
