MOBILEHOME PARKS

- 4,472 Mobilehome Parks in state
- 560,000 MH-units in and outside of Parks, approx. 1.6 million residents
- HCD has enforcement responsibility for 82% of parks for MPM Inspection Program
 - 3,646 MH parks, 295,954 lots
 - 5% parks per year (185 parks, 38,029 lots)
- Construction permit & other inspections
 - 26,266 per year
- 64,295 total MHP inspections per year

SPECIAL OCCUPANCY PARKS (SOPS)

- 716 Special Occupancy Parks in state
- HCD has enforcement responsibility for 82% of SOPs
 - 590 SOPs, 45,540 lots

MOBILEHOME ASSISTANCE CENTER

- Triage & Investigate Complaints
- Receives approximately 3,500 complaints annually
- Referral to local and community resources.
- Provide Outreach and Support

FIELD OPERATIONS (MP/SOP/EH)

- HCD currently has 52 field inspectors but workload has significantly increased over last decade
- Requesting 10 new PY's funded by fees
 - 2 administrators (supervision of inspectors)
 - 4 inspectors (inspections, investigations, field monitoring)
 - 4 office staff (administrative duties)

- Registration Operations
 Statewide for mobilehomes,
 manufactured homes,
 commercial modular, and
 floating homes
- Supported by statutory and regulatory fees;








REGISTRATION AND TITLING

REGISTRATION AND TITLING

- Approx. 72,000 titling application packages per year
- Approx. 2,000 titling application packages left unprocessed, each year, resulting in a compounding backlog
- Approx. 205,000 annual registration renewals
- Registration and Titling currently has 79.5 authorized positions
- Requesting 4 PYs to increase capacity
 - 3 Associate Governmental Program Analysts
 - 1 Staff Services Manager I



DIVISION OF CODES AND STANDARDS

FACTORY-BUILT HOUSING

- Certify and oversee thirdparty inspectors and Plan Reviewers
- Conduct Monitoring Audits (worldwide)
- Staffed by one District Representative and an Administrator.
- Requesting 1 PY dedicated to FBH inspections.
