ISSUE 1	BUDGET AND PROGRAM REVIEW AND SENIOR NUTRITION ADVOCACY PROPOSAL These issues were held open.
ISSUE 2	MULTIPURPOSE SENIOR SERVICES PROGRAM UPDATE AND ADVOCACY PROPOSAL The MSSP issue was held open, however the Subcommittee asked the LAO to provide technical assistance in the more formal drafting of proposed Supplemental Report Language pursuant to the advocates' request for the Subcommittee to consider adopting later in the process. MSA is requested to also provide mock-up trailer bill with their proposed changes to all relevant parties in the budget process to be considered as part of the consideration of the CalMediconnect proposed reauthorizing statute.
ISSUE 3	LONG-TERM CARE OMBUDSMAN PROGRAM UPDATE AND ADVOCACY PROPOSAL This issue was held open, however the Subcommittee requested the assistance of the LAO with crafting a potential option of Budget Bill Language that allows for the on-going transfer of \$1 million from the State Health Facilities Citation Penalties Account every year in which the balance in the account reaches a certain level. The pacing or timing of this should be considered to allow for sufficient planning for the Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program so that the resources can be used prudently and adequately for hiring staff. LAO is requested to consult with the Department of Finance, Department of Public Health, and the California Department of Aging as they develop this option.

ISSUE 1	BUDGET REVIEW, BUDGET CHANGE PROPOSAL, AND ADVOCACY PROPOSAL This issue was held open, however the Subcommittee requested that the DOF work with CSL prior to the May Revision on a feasible path forward to ensure its survival until such time as the tax revenue can make CSL self-sustaining again.
