**Remote Testimony Stations (RTS) in Capitol Park,
on the east side of the Capitol building**

Due to social distancing requirements, today's hearing will include the use of tele- conferencing technology to facilitate panelists and will have a moderated telephone line to assist with public

participation at the hearing. The hearing itself can be viewed remotely through the live stream on the Assembly's website.

After the panel presentations have concluded, and after the conclusion of member questions, the public may provide public comment by using the toll-free number and access code provided above.

In addition to public comment by phone, the Assembly is piloting Remote Testimony Stations (RTS) in Capitol Park, on the east side of the Capitol building. The RTSs will consist of mobile videoconferencing equipment that allows public comment via a dedicated video link. These stations will be located near the Capitol Park fish pond and will be staffed by technical personnel and Sergeants to assist the public. These stations will allow the public to remain physically distanced and provide testimony without the need to enter the Capitol building. These mobile locations will be open 15 minutes prior to the committee hearing. Please note that no seating is available at these remote locations.
