

SENATE THIRD READING
SB 89 (Skinner)
As Amended January 25, 2021

SUMMARY:

Amends the 2020-21 Budget Act to provide the Department of Housing and Community Development the ability to transfer federal funding between Local Assistance and State Operations.

Major Provisions

Adds technical provisional language to the 2020-21 budget act to allow the Department of Housing and Community Development the ability to transfer funds between State Operations and Local Assistance.

COMMENTS:

This bill amends the 2020-21 Budget Act, SB 74 (Mitchell, Chapter 6 of 2020), to allow the Department of Housing and Community Development additional flexibility to use federal funding for either local assistance or state operations purposes. This bill is a companion to provisions in SB 91 and AB 80 which appropriates federal funds for eviction prevention. The additional flexibility would provide local jurisdictions that receive a direct allocation of these federal funds the option to use the State contractor to provide services.

This bill makes technical changes to the 2020 budget act to facilitate the adoption of eviction prevention legislation.
