1	California State Library	\$14 million one-time General Fund support and nine additional permanent State Library positions for enhanced digitization activities. The library is digitizing library records and documents from various state agencies.	Approve with LAO-suggested reporting language	BBL
2	California State Library	\$8.8 million one-time General Fund to support online job and education training platforms, such as GED programs, licensure test preparation, and short-term certificate programs free to library customers.	Approve	BBL
3	California State Library	\$5 million ongoing General Fund to increase support for the Lunch at the Library program, which provides federally-funded lunches to youth during summer. About \$4.7 million would go to local libraries to create or expand the program, while \$300,000 would support two State Library positions to implement the expanded grant program and provide local libraries technical assistance.	Approve with LAO-suggested reporting language	BBL
4	California State Library	\$2.2 million ongoing General Fund to support increased rental costs for the Library and Courts II building.	Approve	BBL
5	University of California	\$10 million one-time General Fund to support the University of California San Francisco Dyslexia Center. The center will use the funding to expand implementation of its dyslexia screening tool in K-12 settings.	Approve	BBL
6	Hastings College of the Law	\$2 M ongoing General Fund to support base operational increase. Funding would be used to support faculty and staff salaries and other operational expenses	Approve	BBL

7	California Student Aid Commission	Trailer bill language would increase the Dreamer Service Incentive Grant (DISG) award amount for participating students and redirect unspent funds to the Dream Loan Program. The program allows student who are ineligible for federal work study programs to earn money working for California non-profits. The proposal would increase the maximum DISG award amount from \$1,500 to \$2,250 per semester (or from \$1,000 to \$1,500 per quarter). Under this proposal, full time students would in effect earn \$15 per hour of service.	Adopt placeholder trailer bill language that includes the LAO recommendation to add a reporting requirement for DSIG, a modification of the proposed increase in DSIG award amounts to cover part-time students, and language that authorizes re-direction of unspent funds to Dream Loans. Also expand eligibility to both Cal Grant A and B students.	TBL
8	California Student Aid Commission	\$300 million one-time General Fund for the Learning-Aligned Employment program, which provides a two-year total of \$500 million when combined with funds provided to establish the program in the 2021 Budget Act. This funding level was part of the 2021-22 budget agreement. The program provides grants to students working part-time jobs aligned with their major.	Approve	BBL
9	California Community Colleges	General Obligation bond funding of \$373 million one-time for the construction phase of 17 projects and the working drawings phase of one other project. Source of the funds is Proposition 51.	Approve	BBL
