(2.5 Percent Enrollment Growth Funding)

## Add Provision to Item 6440-001-0001:

The amount appropriated in Schedule (1) includes funding for the University of California to enroll 205,976 full-time equivalent (FTE) students (excluding students in nonstate supported summer instruction programs). The Legislature expects the university to enroll this number of FTE students during the 2005-06 academic year. The university shall report to the Legislature by March 15, 2006, on whether it has met the 2005-06 enrollment goal. This report shall exclude FTE students in non-state supported summer instruction programs. If the university does not meet its enrollment goal, the Director of the Department of Finance shall revert to the General Fund the total amount of enrollment funding associated with the share of the enrollment goal that was not met.

## Add Provision to Item 6610-001-0001:

The amount appropriated in Schedule (1) includes funding for the California State University to enroll 332,223 full-time equivalent (FTE) students (excluding students in non-state supported summer instruction programs). The Legislature expects the university to enroll this number of FTE students during the 2005-06 academic year. The university shall report to the Legislature by March 15, 2006, on whether it has met the 2005-06 enrollment goal. This report shall exclude FTE students in non-state supported summer instruction programs. If the university does not meet its enrollment goal, the Director of the Department of Finance shall revert to the General Fund the total amount of enrollment funding associated with the share of the enrollment goal that was not met.
